The Preparation for the Prophecy

Isaiah 20:1
The Circumstances

In the year which Tartan came into Ashdod, when Sargon the king of Assyria sent him, that he fought against Ashdod, and captured it;

Isaiah 20:2
The Commands

2 at that time Yahweh had spoken by the hand of Isaiah the son of Amoz, saying, Go and you will have loosened the sackcloth from upon your loins, and pull off your sandal off from upon your foot. And he did in this way, walking naked and barefoot.

Isaiah 20:3-6
The Pronouncement of the Prophecy

Isaiah 20:3-4
The Comparison

3 And Yahweh said, "As which My servant Isaiah had walked naked and barefoot three years *for* a sign and a wonder upon Egypt and upon Ethiopia)

4 that in this way shall the king of Assyria lead away the Egyptian captives, and the Ethiopian exiles, young and old; naked and barefoot, and with *their* buttocks uncovered; *to* the shame of Egypt.

The Consequences

5 And they shall have been terrified and will have been ashamed from Ethiopia their confidence, and from Egypt their glory.

6 And the ones dwelling in this coast shall have said in that day, "Look, in this way is our confidence, which there we have fled to for help, to be delivered from the presence of the king of Assyria; and, How shall we escape?"
