Isaiah 55:1-5:

The Provision of The Servant

Isaiah 55:1 The Call to The Banquet

1) Hey, everyone thirsting, come to the waters; and who *has* no money, come, buy grain and eat. And, come buy wine and milk without money and without price.

Isaiah 55:2

The Counsel of the Servant

2) Why are you weighing money for what is without bread, and your labor for what is without satisfaction? Listen intently to Me and eat what is good; and let yourself delight in the fatness of your soul.

Literal English Translation

Isaiah 55:3 The Covenant of the Servant

- 3) Incline your ear and come to Me; hear, and your soul shall live; and I will cut *an* everlasting covenant with you, the faithful loving kindness of David.
- 4) Behold, I have given Him for a witness to peoples, a Leader and a Commander of peoples.
- 5) Behold, you will call a nation you will not know; and, a nation *that* has not known you shall run to you, because Yahweh Your God, and for *the* Holy One of Israel; because He will have glorified you.

Isaiah 55:6-13 The Presentation of Salvation

The Call to Yahweh

6) Seek Yahweh while He may be found; call upon Him while He is near.

Isaiah 55:7
The Command to Sinners

7) Let *the* wicked *one* forsake his way and *the* man of iniquity *forsake* his thoughts, and let him return to Yahweh, and He will have compassion upon him; and to our God, because He will multiply to forgive.

Isaiah 55:8-9
The Contrasts Between Yahweh and Man

8) Because My thoughts *are* not your thoughts, and your ways *are* not My ways, *a* declaration of Yahweh.

Literal English Translation

9) Because *as the* heavens have been high from the earth, this way My ways have been high from your ways, and My thoughts from your thoughts.

Isaiah 55:10-11

<u>The Comparisons Between the Word of God and</u>
Rain

- 10) Because like as the rain will come down and the snow from the heavens, and will not return there, except it waters the earth and caused it to bring forth and to bud, and it has given seed to the one sowing and bread to the one eating,
- 11) this way shall My Word be, which will go out of My mouth; it shall not return to Me empty, because it shall have done that which I have pleased, and it shall have prospered *in that* which I have sent it.

Isaiah 55:12-13
The Consequences of Seeking Yahweh

- 12) Because you shall go out in joy and will be led out in peace. The mountains and the hills shall break out *with a* shout of joy before you, and all *the* trees of the field shall clap *their* hand.
- 13) Instead of the thorn-bush, shall sprout up the fir tree; instead of the brier, shall sprout up the myrtle tree; and it shall have been to Yahweh for *a* memorial, for *an* everlasting sign *that* shall not be cut off.
