- 2) according as it has been written in the Prophets, "Behold, I send My messenger beforeYour face, who will prepare Your way before You;
- 3) a voice crying in the wilderness. Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight His paths."
- 4) John came baptizing in the wilderness and preaching *a* baptism of repentance for forgiveness of sins.
- 5) And all the Judean country and the ones of Jerusalem went out to him, and were all baptized by him in the Jordan River, confessing their sins.
- 6) And John was clothed in camel's hair, and *a* leather belt around his waist, and eating locusts and wild honey.
