Mark 3:1-6

The Curing of the Withered Hand

- 1) And He entered again into the synagogue, and *a* man was there having the hand withered.
- 2) And they were watching Him, if He will heal him *on* the sabbaths, in order that they might accuse Him.
- 3) And He says to the man the one having the hand withered, "Rise into the midst."
- 4) And He says to them, "Is it lawful to do good on the sabbaths, or to do evil? To save life, or to kill?" But the ones were silent.
- 5) And after having looked around *at* them with anger, while being greatly grieved over the hardness of their heart, He says to the man, "Stretch out your hand." And he stretched *it* out, and his hand was restored whole as the other.
- 6) And after having gone out, the Pharisees immediately were taking counsel with the Herodians against Him, how they might destroy Him.

The Confession of Demons

- 7) And Jesus withdrew with His disciples to the sea; and a great multitude from Galilee followed Him, and from Judea,
- 8) and from Jerusalem, and from Idumea, and beyond the Jordan, and the ones around Tyre and Sidon, *a* great multitude, having heard how much He was doing, came to Him.

- 9) And He spoke to His disciples in order that a boat might wait for Him on account of the crowd, in order that they might not press upon Him.
- 10) For He healed many, so as to fall upon Him, in order that they might touch Him, as many as were having diseases.
- 11) And whenever the unclean spirits were observing Him, *they* were falling down before Him, and were crying out, saying, "You Yourself are the Son of God!"
- 12) And often He was rebuking them in order that they might not make Him known.

- 13) And He goes up into the mountain, and He calls to Himself whom He Himself was desiring. And they came to Him.
- 14) And He appointed twelve, in order that they might be with Him and in order that He might send them to preach
- 15) and to have authority to heal the diseases, and to cast out the demons;
- 16) and He added to Simon the name Peter;
- 17) and James the *son* of Zebedee, and John the brother of James; He added to them *the* names Boanerges, which is, Sons of Thunder;
- 18) and Andrew and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and James the *son* of Alpheus, and Thaddaeus, and Simon the Canaanite,
- 19) and Judas Iscariot, who also delivered Him over.
