Introduction

- 28) **And it happened after these words, about eight days, also after having taken Peter and John and James, He went up into the mountain to pray.**
- 29) **And it happened as He was praying, the appearance of His face *became* different, and His clothing *was* glistening white.**
- 30) **and behold, two men were speaking with Him, who were Moses and Elijah,**

Literal Translation

- 31) **who, having appeared in glory, were speaking of His exodus which He was about to fulfill in Jerusalem.**
- 32) **And Peter and the ones with him were heavy *with* sleep; and after they were fully awake they saw His glory and the two men who had been standing with Him.**
- 33) **And it happened, as they were departing from Him, Peter said to Jesus, “Master, it is good *for* us to be here; and we should make three tents, one for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah; not having known what he is saying.**
- 34) **And while He was speaking these things, *a* cloud came and overshadowed them; and they became afraid as the entered into the cloud.**

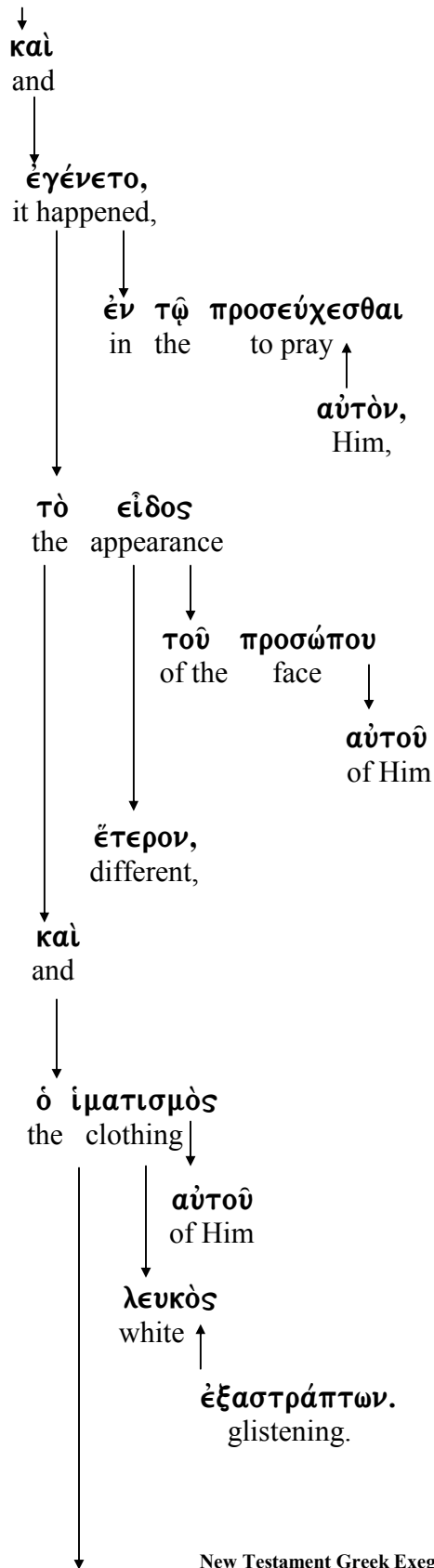
