II Thessalonians 3:1-5 The Confidence of Paul

- 1) The rest, brothers, be praying concerning us, in order that the Word of the Lord might run and might be glorified, according as also with you,
- 2) and in order that we might be delivered from the perverse and evil men; for the faith *is* not of all *people*.

- 10) For even when we were with you, this we were commanding you that If anyone does not desire to work, neither let him eat.
- 11) For we hear some walking disorderly among you, not working at all, but being busybodies.
- 12) Now we command to such ones, and we encourage through our Lord Jesus Christ, in order that working with quietness they might eat their own bread.
- 13) but you yourselves, brothers, should not faint while doing well.
- 14) But if anyone does not obey our word through the letter, mark this one, and do not associate with him, in order that he might be ashamed.
- 15) And do not count *him* as *an* enemy, but warn *him* as *a* brother.
