


6 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.


7 And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.



15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.











Confirming the souls of the disciples, and exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that we must through much <u>tribulation</u> enter into the kingdom of God.
