Accent Rule #1:

The accent stands over the vowel of a syllable.

Accent Rule #2:

The accent stands over the second vowel of a diphthong.

Breathing Mark Rules

Breathing Mark Rule #1:

A breathing mark is always placed over a vowel or a diphthong at the beginning of a word.

Breathing Mark Rule #2:

When a breathing mark is in a word, it will <u>always</u> be placed over a vowel or the second vowel in a diphthong.

Breathing Mark #3

When a breathing mark and an accent mark stand over the same vowel, the breathing mark is placed first, then the accent mark; except with the circumflex accent, which stands over the breathing mark.

Breathing Mark #4

A UPSILON (v) or RHO (ρ) at the beginning of a word will always have a rough breathing mark, except in diphthongs.
