### IMPERFECT MIDDLE INDICATIVE OF λύω

	<u>SINGULAR</u>	<u>PLURAL</u>
1 <sup>st</sup> PERSON	<b>ἐλύομην</b> I was loosing for myself	<b>ἐλύομεθα</b> we were loosing for ourselves
2 <sup>nd</sup> PERSON	<b>ἐλύου</b> you (thou) were loosing for yourself	<b>ἐλύεσθε</b> you (ye) were loosing for yourselves
3 <sup>rd</sup> PERSON	<b>ἐλύετο</b> he was loosing for himself	<b>ἐλύοντο</b> they were loosing for themselves

### IMPERFECT MIDDLE INDICATIVE AUGMENT AND ENDINGS

	<u>SINGULAR</u>	<u>PLURAL</u>
1 <sup>st</sup> PERSON	I ----- <b>ἐ...ομην</b>	we ----- <b>ἐ...ομεθα</b>
2 <sup>nd</sup> PERSON	you (thou) ----- <b>ἐ...ου</b>	you (ye) ---- <b>ἐ...εσθε</b>
3 <sup>rd</sup> PERSON	he, she, it ----- <b>ἐ...ετο</b>	they ----- <b>ἐ...οντο</b>

### IMPERFECT PASSIVE INDICATIVE OF λύω

	<u>SINGULAR</u>	<u>PLURAL</u>
1 <sup>st</sup> PERSON	<b>ἐλύομην</b> I was being loosed	<b>ἐλύομεθα</b> we were being loosed
2 <sup>nd</sup> PERSON	<b>ἐλύου</b> you (thou) were being loosed	<b>ἐλύεσθε</b> you (ye) were being loosed
3 <sup>rd</sup> PERSON	<b>ἐλύετο</b> he was being loosed	<b>ἐλύοντο</b> they were being loosed
