Matthew 5-7 = Sermon on the Mount

Luke 6 = Sermon on the Plain

Matthew 5-7 = written for the Jews

Luke 6 = written for the Gentiles

Matthew 5-7 = The Sermon on the Mount

addresses the spiritual condition

Luke 6 = The Sermon on the Plain

addresses the physical condition

Two different messages
teaching the same basic principles.

Luke focuses on four attitudes:

1 - toward circumstances in verses 20-26

2 - toward people in verses 27-38

3 - toward ourselves in verses 39-45

4 - toward God in verses 46-49

The Contrasts of Life:
Attitudes Toward Circumstances

Four Blessings

Not "happy" from the Anglo-Saxon word "happenstance" meaning "you're circumstances have been good for you"

makario~ (MAKARIOS) meaning "to experience the fullness of something"

Four Woes

woe = to pronounce destruction on someone

poor = physical poverty

Isaiah 61:1-2

1 The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound;

2 To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn;

Hearken, my beloved brethren, Hath not God chosen the poor of this world rich in faith, and heirs of the kingdom which he hath promised to them that love him?
