Technical term for God-fearers

Also known as Proselytes of the Gate

- 1) not Jews
- 2) worship as a Jew
- 3) keep Sabbath Day and festivals
- 4) not circumcised nor MIKVAH
(required to convert to Judaism)

TALIT = prayer shawl

TZIT-ZIT = tassels bound
at four corners

strings represent 613
commandments of God

tied in the form of the four
letters of God's name

received the Holy Spirit

Everything centers around

Acts 10:44

And, being assembled together with *them*, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, *saith he*, ye have heard of me.

Acts 1:5

For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence.

I Corinthians 12:13

For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether *we be* Jews or Gentiles, whether *we be* bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

ISOS = equal

John 5:18

Therefore the Jews sought the more to kill him, because he not only had broken the sabbath, but said also that God was his Father, making himself equal with God.

- 3) half-million Jews in Antioch
