Romans 2:1

Therefore thou art inexcusable, O man,
whosoever thou art that judgest: for wherein

for thou that judgest doest the same *things*.

Philippians 4:2

I beseech Euodias, and beseech Syntyche, that *they* be of the same mind in the Lord.
