I Corinthians 8-10 The Meat Offered to Idols

I Corinthians 8:1-3 The Problem of Knowledge

I Corinthians 8:1

Now as touching things offered unto idols, we know that we all have knowledge. Knowledge puffeth us, but charity edifieth.

Knowledge has trouble with love -Love has trouble with knowledge.

Romans 10:2

For I bear them record that they have a zeal of God, but not according to knowledge.

I Corinthians 8:4-8 The Presentation of Knowledge

I Corinthians 8:4

As concerning therefore the eating of those things that are offered in sacrifice unto idols, we know that an idol is nothing in the world, and that there is none other God but one.

I Corinthians 8:7

Howbeit *there is* not in every man that knowledge: for some with conscience of the idol unto this hour eat *it* as a thing offered unto an idol; and their conscience being weak is defiled.

I Corinthians 8:9-12 The Precaution Concerning Knowledge

I Corinthians 8:9

But take heed lest by any means this liberty of yours become a stumblingblock to them that are weak.

I Corinthians 8:13 The Portrayal of Knowledge

I Corinthians 8:13

Wherefore, if meat make my brother to offend, I will eat no flesh while the world standeth, lest I make my brother to offend.

I Corinthians 9:1-27 The Position of Paul

I Corinthians 9:11-12 Participation

I Corinthians 9:11-12

11 If we have sown unto you spiritual things, is it a great thing if we shall reap your carnal things?
12 If others be partakers of this power over you, are not we rather? Nevertheless we have not used this power; but suffer all things, lest we should hinder the gospel of Christ.

I Corinthians 9:15-18 Motivation

I Corinthians 9:18

What is my reward then? *Verily* that, when I preach the gospel, I may make the gospel of Christ without charge, that I abuse not my power in the gospel.

I Corinthians 9:19-23 Summation

I Corinthians 9:19

For though I be free from all *men*, yet have I made myself servant unto all, that I might gain the more.

I Corinthians 9:24-27 Preparation

I Corinthians 9:24-27

- 24 Know ye not that they which run in a race run all, but one receiveth the prize? So run, that ye may obtain.
- 25 And every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate in all things. Now they *do it* to obtain a corruptible crown; but we an incorruptible.
- 26 I therefore so run, not as uncertainly; so fight I, not as one that beateth the air:
- 27 But I keep under my body, and bring *it* into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway.

I Corinthians 10:6-10 4 things Characteristics of the Lusters

Matthew 4:6

Psalm 91:11-12

Deuteronomy 6:16

We complain because of our lust.

Christian Life - 3 phases

- 1) Salvation through the Red Sea
- 2) Spiritual Growth Wilderness Journey
- 3) Spiritual Maturity Promised Land

I Corinthians 6:12

All things are lawful unto me, but all things are not expedient: all things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought under the power of any.

This life is not about acquiring for oneself but rather how your life influences another person's life.

Head = does not mean superiority

Father is the head of the son in function.

Men and women are equal but have different functions and responsibilities.

I Peter 3:7

Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with *them* according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered.

Not because men are better teachers or more knowledgeable but it is God's order

Matthew 10:34-37

- 34 Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword.
- 35 For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law.
- 36 And a man's foes *shall be* they of his own household.
- 37 He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.

Teaching = to saved

For there must be also heresies among you, that they which are approved may be made manifest among you.

I John 2:19
